
RE: Alumni Report 2021

The Office of Alumni Affairs prepared the following 2021 Alumni Report that reflects selected characteristics of MD graduates of SIU School of Medicine. Throughout the many years that this office has provided this report, the percentages have only slightly changed re: Current Specialty of Alumni in Practice. This report reflects a 2% growth within the discipline of surgery in the past two years. The data is current as of November 2021. Following are some highlights:

- 1. A total of 3,094 SOM MD students have graduated from the class of 1975 through the class of 2021. We have 2,996 living alumni; 98 deceased alumni (3%).
- 2. Of those alumni in practice (2,342/76%), the specialties that have attracted the most significant numbers are Family Medicine (481/21%), Internal Medicine (454/19%), and Surgery (325/14%). We have provided a breakdown of the subspecialties.
- 3. Thirty-four percent of alumni in practice are in one of the primary care specialties of General Family Medicine, General Internal Medicine, General Pediatrics, or Medicine/Pediatrics. Since 2017, this number has decreased by 4%.
- 4. Alumni are currently practicing in 47 states except for Delaware, Vermont, and Wyoming. The most significant number (943/43%) is practicing in 68 Illinois counties. We have 480 practicing in the 66-county SIU service areas.
- 5. 1,855 (60%) male alumni and 1,239 (40%) female alumni; the percentages remained the same as the 2019 report.
  - Oldest alum = 85yo; youngest = 25yo; Average = 55yo
  - 16% are 65yo+; 22% are 55-64yo; 23% are 45-54yo; 22% are 35-44yo; 17% are 24-34yo.


Figure 1: CURRENT PROFESSIONAL STATUS OF ALUMNI






Figure 3: ALUMNI IN PRIMARY CARE PRACTICE
